



NOTICE OF VACANCY

LAKE CITY PORT AUTHORITY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS

The City of Lake City is seeking applicants to fill a vacancy on the **Lake City Port Authority Board of Commissioners**, a unit of municipal government established to promote and support economic development and related activities within the City of Lake City, Minnesota.

The Port Authority is governed by a Board of Commissioners appointed by the City Council of Lake City. Commissioners participate in meetings and provide leadership and oversight regarding Port Authority activities, projects, and initiatives.

Who May Apply

Applicants must be eligible to serve as a Port Authority Commissioner under applicable Minnesota law and the City of Lake City's ordinances and policies. Residents with an interest in the community's economic development, employment and business environment are encouraged to apply.

Experience in business, finance, economic development, real estate, planning, community development, or related fields is welcome, but applicants with a broad range of backgrounds and community experience are encouraged to apply.

Term of Appointment

The appointment will fill the current vacancy for the remainder of the applicable term, ending in 2032.

The Board generally meets the third Thursday of each month, in person, at 4:30 p.m. Commissioners should be prepared to attend regular meetings and participate in Port Authority activities as needed.
